Instructions for Completing the Application for Electrical Materials Suppliers Provisional Registration

The SLEWRC advises that all items be submitted as a complete package or the SLEWRC will find it difficult to process the application in the best timeframe. The business name must be *exactly the same on all documents*.

A complete **Electrical Materials Suppliers Registration Form** includes:

1. The Registration Form must be filled out *completely* including:

- a. **Taxpayers Identification Number (TIN):** Issued by the National Revenue Authority (NRA). You will also need this number to obtain a full license.
- b. **Legal Status:** If not a sole proprietor or partnership, must be registered with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC).

(Sole proprietorship and partnerships should register with the Office of the Registrar General (ORG) while companies or corporations should register with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC))

2. **Designated Chief Technician or Master Electrician:** Only one chief technician / master electrician can be *assigned* to the business at a time. The one chief technician / master electrician must either be an owner/proprietor or a supervisory employee who agrees to perform the duties of the administrator/master.
